Summer of Semillon

Semillon, one of the key heritage varieties in South Africa, is now largely forgotten. There are still a number of incredible, old Semillon vineyards in existence, especially in Swartland and Franschoek. One of the key characteristics of these old vineyards, unique to South Africa, is the inter-planting of Semillon Blanc (Groen Druif) and Semillon Gris (Rooi Groen Druif).

The characteristics of semillon are widely evident in the wines listed, all of which have been matured in oak and go fantastically well with our food! Expect wines that are “hauntingly difficult to define”, golden and sometimes burnished copper (from the Semillon Gris). On the nose an unexpected array of aromatics - complex with hints of citrus. The wines are all elegantly structured, giving lovely concentration and depth which lingers on the palate.

Raised by Wolves La Colline “Groen Druif” 2016 The first of our Franschoek “La Colline” selection, using Semillon Blanc.		R500
Boekenhoutskloof Semillon 2015 Predominantly from the oldest vineyard in South Africa planted in 1902, and small parcels from La Colline and another 75 year old vineyard.		R600
Thorne & Daughters Paper Kite 2016 Made from two vineyards in Swartland and Franschoek that are 52 and 85 years old respectively, includes both Semillon Blanc and Semillon Gris.		R630
Thorne & Daughters Tin Soldier 2015 Skin-fermented blend of Semillon Blanc and Gris, from vineyards in Swartland and Franschoek that are 5 and 32 years old respectively.		R630
Klein Constantia Semillon 2004 These relatively young (11 years at time of vintage) Semillon vineyards were planted for blending, and in exceptional years a single variety was made. Beautiful aged Semillon.		R850
Black Elephant Vintners The Dark Side of the Vine 2015 Single vineyard Franschoek vines from the Bo-Hoek Valley planted in 1905. The wine uses both Semillon Blanc and Gris. Epitomises everything we love about old-vine Semillon.		R950
Alheit Vineyards La Colline 2015 The second of our La Colline selection using approximately 15% Semillon Gris and 85% Semillon Blanc – using the grapes as they grow. The superlative Semillon.		R1050
