



**Soixante Quinze (French 75)** R90

**Louis Bouillot Grand Réserve Brut | NV** R420  
*Burgundy | Pinot Noir, Chardonnay* glass R80  
Pale yellow colour with green tints. A complex nose with aromas of peach and then nuances of flower. The finish is lovely and well-balanced.

**Domaine William Fèvre Chablis Village | 2015** R495  
*Burgundy | Chardonnay* glass R115  
A cool, pure and elegant nose speaks of citrus, oyster shell, white flowers and iodine hints. There is excellent volume for a villages level wine with very good mid-palate concentration present on the medium-bodied flavors that conclude in a citrusy, clean and very dry finale.

**Château Lagrézette Purple Malbec | 2016** R260  
*Cahors | Malbec* glass R60  
With its soft tannins, touch of smokiness and blackberry-juice fruit flavours, Purple is a fine showpiece for the more open side of Malbec.

**Bouchard Père & Fils Pinot Noir La Vignée | 2015** R395  
*Burgundy | Pinot Noir* glass R90  
Garnet colour with mauve to violet shades. The nose is typical of Pinot Noir with red and black fruit notes to which is added a hint of kirsch. The mouth is balanced between suppleness and fruit.

**Saint Cosme Côtes-du-Rhône Rouge | 2016** R335  
*Rhône Valley | Syrah*  
The region combines old vines, magnificent terroirs, fairly low yields and an outstanding climate. This 2016 vintage shows top quality fruit of blackcurrant and wild raspberry, magnificently intense color and layered texture with notes of truffle and licorice.

**Domaine La Roquette Châteauneuf-du-Pape Piedlong | 2013** R1290  
*Rhône Valley | Grenache, Mourvedre*  
Vinified with plenty of stems and aged all in foudre, it offers lots of plum, blackberry and bouquet garni like characteristics in a medium to full-bodied, supple, sexy style. This wine has impressive sweetness of fruit and a forward, delicious style.

**Domaine Fourrier Gevrey Chambertin Village | 2015** R1390  
*Burgundy | Pinot Noir*  
There is lovely intensity to the precise, tautly muscular and relatively powerful medium-bodied flavours that possess solid mid-palate volume before delivering very good complexity on the once again mildly austere, long and balanced finale.
